About Ishmael Wadada Leo Smith:

Ishmael Wadada Leo Smith is one of the outstanding American musicians of his generation. A ground-breaking trumpeter and composer, he was a key member of the seminal Association for the Advancement of Creative Musicians. Alongside artists such as Henry Threadgill, Anthony Braxton and the Art Ensemble of Chicago, he has pioneered new possibilities in creative music. A lecturer at California Institute of the Arts he eschews simple labels preferring the description of “creative musician”. His compositions cross all boundaries from blues through jazz to contemporary classical and he is able to balance broad concepts of form with exquisitely delicate sounds. The tonal range and the warmth of his trumpet playing is breathtaking.

Pat Thomas (piano & electronics) is one of the most highly respected musicians on the international jazz and free improvisation scene. He has worked with the legendary guitarist Derek Bailey, Tony Oxley, Lol Coxhill, Phil Minton etc. He has a ever widening discography, has recently been touring in Britain and abroad with the dance group the Cholmondeleys, and also plays in “About Group”. Pat has been a leading figure in the re-establishment of Oxford Improvisers since 2001 and COHESION since 2006.

Alexander Hawkins is a pianist, hammond organist, composer and band-leader. He is a regular musical partner of the seminal South African drummer Louis Moholo-Moholo, and has also appeared alongside Evan Parker, Joe McPhee, Sonny Simmons, Lol Coxhill, and countless others. His work has been broadcast frequently on the BBC and abroad. A busy performance schedule takes him throughout Europe, and as far afield as Russia and Brazil.
